- Visit **Longwood Gardens** regarded as one of the world's great gardens. Once the private estate of Pierre S. du Pont, today's the Gardens is a magnificent 1,000 acre horticultural showplace.
- The **Peirce-du Pont House**, located on the grounds, features a fascinating exhibition addressing various stages in the estate's two centuries of history--from Quaker Joshua Peirce's 1730 modest beginning through Pierre DuPont's 1907 acquisition and Twentieth Century expansions.
- **Visit Philadelphia Museum of Art** for a private tour, before the museum opens for the day. Special exhibit: *Van Gogh up Close*. In 1886, while living in Paris, van Gogh dramatically altered his manner of painting landscapes and still exceptional examples borrowed from notable collections around the world.
- Lunch in **Water Works Restaurant**.
